- 2. MINUTES The Minutes of the previous Meeting were read and confirmed.
- 3. MATTERS ARISING Increase in 1978 Subs. Should this not be 1977? 1978 is correct.
- 4. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT As the Report had appeared in the last Mag, it was taken as read. Roger poroposed its adoption, Gerald seconded.
