

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE DURBAN
RAMBLERS' CLUB, CONVENED IN ROOM 31, LONDON ASSURANCE
BUILDINGS, ON TUESDAY, 20TH FEBRUARY, 1951, AT 8 P.M.

52 Members were present.

The Chairman declared the Meeting open at
8.15 p.m.

The Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held
on the 7th February, 1950, were read and moved for confirmation
by L. Duffey and seconded by S. Griffiths.

The Chairman read his report on the Club's
activities for the year and thanked Committee Members for
their loyal support.

The Treasurer submitted the Balance Sheet,
and enlarged on the various accounts. It was concluded that
the Club's financial position was very sound. During the year,
£30 had been placed on Fixed Deposit with the S.A. Permanent
Building Society.

The Officers of the new Committees were
elected by members present.

Mr. Dennison was unanimously elected as
Auditor for 1951.

Honoraria were voted to the Secretary, Miss
P. Ogle, the Hon. Treasurer, Mr. D. Gaydon, and Miss J.
Dawson in recognition of her assistance in the preparation of
circulars.

GENERAL : The proposed Amble was brought forward for
discussion by Mr. T. Lusignia. The Chairman reported on this
matter and the subject was further enlarged on by Mr. Hodges.

J. Rodgers suggested a new route starting from the Track
Grounds to the Whynott Tea Room and back through Red Hill -
a distance of approximately twelve miles, ^{which he had done} and would furthermore
be a good advertisement for the Club. In replying to Mr.
Rodgers, D. Gaydon said that, on the contrary, this would be
an advertisement in the wrong direction.

Mr. Rodgers further stated that in his opinion the last Social Dance
which was held at Athlone Gardens was not a very friendly affair.
He also maintained that the Club, forming the majority of the crowd
as on that occasion, should have more control over the Orchestra,
as he thought the music very dull.

The Meeting closed at 4 minutes to 10 p.m.
